David Hicks will call or e-mail the homeowner who has been out of town to see when he plans to return and can take care of the necessary tree removal.

ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE:

The garage project at 18791Pagentry Place has been completed; garage project at 735 Piney Ridge Way is still being done.

New issues for the Committee are consideration of placement of a direct television antenna, placement of the hot tub and placement of a cat enclosure at 18826 Pagentry Place. Catherine Dove will contact the homeowner to set up a meeting to discuss.

There is a new request from 807 Piney Ridge Way for a temporary enclosure for a new puppy.

Red Oak Management Company will be asked to notify the Board if there are any violations.

ROAD REPAIR:

Pat Burch will contact the county to see what is happening with scheduling road repairs in Tall Pines Ranch Home Association. The county was contacted last year but has not done any repair work.

NEW BUSINESS:

Pat Burch will ask the county to inspect drainage area in three lots (lots 7, 15 and 50) for detention basin.

David Hicks will look at issues on outer fences.
